## **Opening Session**

- O Special Speech
- Currently, tourism activities among countries in Northeast Asia have been lively but the benefits have been limited to the large cities. Due to the spread of consumption-oriented tourism activities, there has been continuous destruction of local ecology, culture, and environment.
- Necessity of setting-up a system for cooperation and information sharing for mutual understanding and exercising sustainable development of tourism in Northeast Asia
- By the sharing and researching of exemplary tourism practices in Northeast Asia, sustainable development strategies for local tourism will be introduced. Furthermore, there will be discussions regarding the direction of future tourism through various means such as a joint certification system of tourism destinations among the NEAR members.

#### Session I

#### < Topic : Tourism and Regional Development >

O Northeast Asia regional governments will examine and draw implications from successful cases of tourism development which

- have been tried and tested in Northeast Asian countries in order to direct and pursue tourism development policies.
- Discussion on cooperation methods and policies of central and regional governments for the successful development of local tourism.

#### Session II

#### < Topic : Sustainable Tourism and International Cooperation >

- O Policies and Successful Cases of Sustainable Tourism
  - Sharing national policies on tourism and successful cases
  - Seeking out roles of national and regional governments, tour companies, and customers can play in contributing to the development of sustainable tourism
- O Adoption of a System for Sustainable Tourism and International Cooperation: Policy Making for the adoption of a system for securing sustainability of eco-tourism based on the principles of saving and effective usage of resources, and the mutual understanding of the environmental, cultural, and historical resource of the region, as well as the revitalization of the network and cooperation in Northeast Asia

## < Topic : Mutual Cooperation on Tourism in Northeast Asia >

O Mutual Cooperation on Tourism and Action Plan: Removal of international tourism, the development of eco-tourism/ sustainable tourism, tourist safety and risk management, joint-marketing, sharing of information on tourism, improvement of tourism statistics, the integration of education and training of tourism

industry labor force and discussion regarding an action plan for the key tasks of international tourism/ discussion regarding an action plan for cooperation in international tourism.

O Importance of promoting practical cooperation on tourism among NEAR members: Adoption of a mutual strategic cooperation system such as one on one or multi-exchange on tourism, attracting more foreign visitors, as well as designing long-term, practical exchange programs such as youth exchange or sister city exchange among the regional governments from the six NEAR member countries.
